Dear Oostburg School District family,

Each school year, the School District of Oostburg offers Free or Reduced Hot Lunch prices through the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) for families that qualify. For Junior Kindergarten students, the Special Milk Program (SMP) is not offered at OES this year. Information on the pre-paid JK Milk Program for snack time will be available at Sneak Peak and/or with your JK teacher.

For the 2017-18 school year, Free & Reduced Lunch paper and online applications will be available on Aug. 1, 2017. Manual application paper copies are still available in each school's office or you can go online to print off at your convenience. Please visit the school's website at: www.oostburg.k12.wi.us/resources/#food. Then select Online Application Instructions tab for more detailed information or go to Free & Reduced Application tab to print off copies of application for manual submission. The online application process is done through the Infinite Campus Parent Portal. It is recommended that you gather household income information needed and review your household members in the Household Information Section of the Parent Portal for accuracy.

For families that receive meal benefits through Direct Certification, you will be notified of approval/denial of benefit prior to Aug. 31, 2017.

Infinite Campus offers low hot lunch balance notifications through the Parent Portal. Here is where you can decide what lunch balance amount you want to be notified at. Please go to your Parent Portal online, go to Notifications settings tab, then go to Low Lunch Balance and select amount specified in the box. Please note this does not override the district wide general notifications you may still receive.
