Dear Oostburg School District family,

Each school year, the School District of Oostburg offers Free or Reduced Hot Lunch prices through the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) for families that qualify. New this year, for Junior Kindergarten students, there will be no applications for state assistance with the milk program available this year. All JK milk for snack will be at a pre-paid rate for the school year. Also new this year, the Kindergarten milk program for snack time has been discontinued.

For the 2017-18 school year, Free & Reduced lunch applications will be mailed to each household after Aug. 1, 2017. Additional application paper copies will be available in each school's office or you can go online to print off at your convenience. Please visit the school's website at: <http://oostburg.k12.wi.us/resources/#food>, to select Online Application Instructions for more detailed information and/or go to Free & Reduced Application for copies to print off for manual submission.

The Infinite Campus online application process is done through the parent portal. There are instructions throughout the process, as you go through it. It is recommended that you gather all household income information, Food Share case number, & review your household members in the household information section of the Parent Portal for accuracy prior to starting the online application.

For families that receive benefits through Direct Certification, you will be notified of approval/denial of benefit prior to Aug. 31, 2017.
