Dear School District of Oostburg Families,

The School District of Oostburg is participating in the USDA Seamless Summer Option (SSO) for the entirety of the 2021-22 school year. This means that our school is providing *FREE* meals to ALL enrolled K-12 OSD students! This program provides additional support and flexibility for our district to continue serving meals to children while maintaining safety measures and managing the impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic. Even though receipt of free meals does not depend on an approved free and reduced-price meal application, we are still distributing and processing them so our families may qualify for P-EBT benefits as well as other school funding.

When your child participates in our healthy and delicious school meals program it will save your family time and money. At lunch students are offered five food components (grain, protein, fruit, vegetable, and fluid milk). For your child's lunch meal to be FREE, they must take at least three different food components, one of which is ½ cup fruit or vegetable. Please note that each school has different portion sizes according to the grade levels. Extra Entrees, a la carte items, milk w/o school meal, or meals that do not meet the requirements described above will be charged the appropriate fees.

Our lunch menus will come out on Aug. 25 for Sneak Peak. Menus and nutrition information are always posted on our district website, under the Quick Links. Click on the "Lunch Menu" tab, select the month, then print it off, and put on your home refrigerator. Give each child the option to choose what days they want to take lunch & mark it on the calendar. This will ease a lot of questions your child(ren) may have.
